

# DISASTER CHECKLIST

The 2018 Atlantic Basin Hurricane Season activity is predicted to be at or above normal. NOW is the time to get ready to weather the storm!

## EVACUATE or SHELTER IN PLACE?

### SUPPLIES

- Five days of non-perishable food
- Three days of drinkable water (1 gallon per person per day)
- SPF 15 or higher Sun Screen
- Mosquito Repellant
- Manual Can Opener and Self-opening Cans
- Extra Cash

### MEDICINE and FIRST-AID

- One month supply of all medications
- First Aid Kit

### ENERGY

- Spare Batteries for Lanterns, Flashlights, AM/FM Radio(s)
- Flashlights and Lanterns
- Generator with a 4 Day Supply of Fuel and Fuel Conditioner
- Propane or Charcoal for Grill to heat food and water (use only outside)

### BUILDING SUPPLIES

- Tarps
- Duct Tape
- Tools (Hammer, Hand Saw, Screwdrivers, Box Cutter or Safety Knife)

### COMMUNICATIONS

- At least one battery-powered AM/FM Radio and spare batteries
- Cell Phone and Charger (capable of charging from car battery)
- FRS or Ham Radio Transceiver with Charger (Ham requires a FCC License to transmit)
